MARAC

If you are experiencing domestic abuse, a referral form may be completed with your safety, and that of any children you have, in mind.

We may need to share this information with our partner agencies.

By answering the questions about your situation, we can try and work out what level of risk you are facing from your partner (or ex-partner).

If the information gathered indicates that you are at a high risk of harm your situation may be discussed in a **MARAC** meeting.

What is a **MARAC**?

It is a meeting where agencies can plan and agree what support they can offer to help keep you (and your children) safe. The aim is to prevent you from being abused again. After the **MARAC** you may be offered advice, support services and equipment to help reduce your risk of harm.
